A dialogical research process: Towards reconciliation after experiences of violence - inviting silent, embodied knowledge for joint exploration of addressed concerns

The presentation will show how questions from young people exposed to violence and misfortune can be brought into the open in search of answers from trusted adults.

By means of sharing the joint development of relational network map, joint art work, storytelling along life lines, it will be elucidated how former, silent, embodied experiences of violence and misfortune can be invited into the open, to be explored and get until than unknown answers from trusted others - in search of a less painful future, reconciliation, and change.

The work will include a short presentation, open reflections from among team members, thereafter invite outside voices for sharing reflections.
